The Collegiate Volunteer Leadership Award of \$500 is granted to two students who have a history of and a focus on continuing leadership and volunteer activities at their college, and in their community.

Why nominate a Student for the Rotary Club of West St. Louis County – Collegiate Volunteer Leadership Award?

Encouraging college students to continue to step forward as leaders at their campus and in their community helps us to ensure a brighter future for each Collegiate Volunteer Leader, those he/she strives to help, and the college and community as a whole.

What are the criteria for nomination?

- Nominee must be a student in good standing at a public institution of higher education whose residence is within the service area of the Rotary Club of West St. Louis County.
 - Winchester, Manchester, Ballwin, Wildwood, Clarkson Valley, Ellisville, Eureka and Valley Park
- Student must be an active leader both on campus and within the community.
- Nominee must be successfully completing their first full year (minimum of 30 credit hours) in college.

Who may nominate a Collegiate Volunteer Leader?

- Teacher
- Club sponsor
- Campus administrator
- Rotary Club representative
- Community volunteer organizer

How do you nominate a Collegiate Volunteer Leader?

1. Complete nomination form
2. Write a letter of recommendation for nomination of the student.
3. Include one additional letter of support.

What should be included in the letter of nomination?

Simply state why you feel the student you nominated should be a candidate for the Rotary Club of West St. Louis County – Collegiate Volunteer Leadership Award. Please include how the student has benefited their campus and local community, their activities beyond the classroom including community involvement, and his/her ability to inspire by their service to others.
