The purpose of the Rotary Club of West St. Louis County Excellence in Education Awards Program is to recognize excellence in the educational professions and to inform the public of the exceptional quality of education in the West St. Louis County area.

Awards Categories:

One educator is honored in each of the following categories:

- Elementary
- High School
- Middle School (grades 6 – 8)
- College/University

Why nominate an educator for the WSLC Rotary Excellence in Education Award?

How often do we regret our failure to praise someone for the positive influence they had on our lives? This is your opportunity to recognize an educator for his or her outstanding contribution to the teaching profession.

Eligibility:

- Nominee must be an educator who instructs or supports the instruction of students on a regular basis.
- Nominee must be in the field during 2018-19 year in an educational institution in RCWSLC Service Area:
 - Winchester, Manchester, Ballwin, Wildwood, Clarkson Valley, Ellisville, Eureka, and Valley Park

Who may nominate an educator?

- A current or former student, or parent
- A member of RCWSLC
- A fellow teacher, staff or administrator
- A civic or community leader

What are the criteria for nomination?

- The most important criterion used in evaluating the nominated educator is the ability to engage and inspire students of all backgrounds and abilities to reach their full potential.

How do you nominate an educator?

1. Complete nomination form
2. Write a letter of recommendation for nomination for the nominee.
3. Include one additional letter of support.
4. Additional letters of support are encouraged.

What should be included in the letter of Nomination?

Simply state why you feel the teacher you nominated should be a candidate for the Excellence in Education Award. It may include how they have affected a particular student or situation, their professionalism, the educator's activities in and beyond the classroom including community involvement, and their ability to instill in his/her students, faculty or staff the desire to do their best and to reach their full potential.
